State Council Updates

Highlights

Missouri's State Council held our first meeting on November 29, 2017, and our second meeting was held on June 5, 2018. At our first meeting, the Council was briefed by MIC3 Executive Director (ED) Cherise Imai on the rules and regulations. The Council also discussed how local school districts support military students, cases encountered, and opportunities to connect with schools and other key stakeholders to disseminate compact information. Our next meeting is scheduled for early October.

In addition, the Council has distributed compact information to the Missouri Association of School Administrators Regional Teams. Lastly, Missouri was involved in bringing the ED Imai to the first annual *Military Connected Schools Summit* in Nashville, Tennessee in mid-July. Attendees included senior leadership and administrators the Waynesville R-VI School District, and school personnel from military school districts in Kansas and New Jersey. Missouri will also be taking part in a joint compact training initiative with Kansas in the near future.
